The First Minister: Prevention and reduction of healthcare-associated infections remains a high priority. Numbers of clostridium difficile infections in all ages continues to fall. Provisional data for April to September 2013 shows the number of such infections in inpatients aged over 65 is 9% lower than in the equivalent period in 2012.
