Dear Chair

Thank you for your letter of 10 February in which you asked for details about the stage we have reached in our due diligence process (in respect of proposals submitted by representatives of Green Man), and the timetable for decision-making on future use of Gilestone Farm.

Our initial due diligence work is at the final stages of assessment and we aim to submit advice and options to Ministers by the end of this month. Depending on the option agreed by Ministers, it is possible that further work will be necessary before a final decision can be taken.

I appreciate the Committee will be considering its approach to further scrutiny, and timing thereof, given its interest in understanding the decision-making process as it relates to Gilestone Farm. I stand ready to describe in more detail the approach we have taken once Ministers have made a final decision on the proposals submitted by representatives of Green Man and agreed next steps.
