Data Justice inquiry: use of personal data in the Welsh NHS

The <u>Equality and Social Justice Committee</u> is undertaking a short inquiry on the subject of <u>data justice</u>. We have recently appointed expert advisers, Dr Lina Dencik and Isobel Rorison of Cardiff University to assist the Committee in this work so I thought now would be a timely opportunity to outline our approach to our work in this area. The focus of the inquiry is on the use of personal data in the Welsh NHS, including how patient data will be used and shared when electronic prescribing (e-prescribing) is rolled out. A one day inquiry has been planned for 27 March 2023, in which we will be seeking evidence from NHS representatives, stakeholders and academics.


We will be considering a number of key questions during the inquiry, a full list of which are available on the <u>inquiry page</u>.
