Active travel is essential to the overall framework for air quality in Wales. In that sense it falls clearly within the remit of the Environment (Air Quality and Soundscapes) (Wales) Bill. However, including such amendments during the passage of the Bill should be approached with caution. Whilst the suggested amendments appear to be sensible without subjecting them to wider consultation there may be other factors or consequences that have not been considered. Much will depend on the evidence that can be produced by the cross-party group to support their amendments.
