MEETINGS

The Group met three times:

20 September 2022 – This meeting focussed on the proposed new innovation strategy for Wales and heard from Abi Phillips, Head of Innovation, Welsh Government. Also included was the groups AGM.

14 March 2023 – At this meeting the CPG members provided updates on their work this year before hearing a presentation and Q&A session with the new Chief Scientific Advisor for Wales, Prof. Jas Pal Badyal. The meeting included discussion of issues related to STEM education and workforce.

12 September 2023 – This meeting focussed on STEM education. We were joined by the Minister for Education and Welsh Language, Jeremy Miles MS, who provided an update on behalf of the Welsh Government before a Q&A session with members. This meeting also contained the groups AGM. David Rees MS was re-elected as Chair, Jack Sergeant MS and Mark Isherwood MS were both elected Vice Chair of the CPG.

Science and the Senedd – The annual Science and the Senedd event was held on Tues 13 June. Whilst not an official CPG meeting the event is organised in conjunction with the CPG on STEMM. The 19th edition of this event was held at the Senedd and Pierhead buildings and focussed on the topic of STEM and the economy. The event was followed by an evening reception and exhibition from more than 20 organisations. The evening reception included speeches by all the political parties in the Senedd and heard from the Minister for Economy.
