Inquiry into the public health approach to preventing gender-based violence

Thank you to you and your colleagues for providing additional information following our evidence session in July in respect of the above.

As we are nearing the end of our evidence gathering, it has become apparent that perpetrator programmes across Wales vary in their format and availability, as well as how they are monitored and evaluated. While we spoke about police referrals to perpetrator programmes briefly during our evidence session, we would be grateful if you could provide an outline of the programmes you are aware of across Wales, and your level of engagement with them. Please could you include details of any perpetrator programmes you fund; why you have chosen to fund these particular perpetrator programmes; and how you make frontline police officers aware of such programmes so they can make appropriate referrals to intervene early to prevent gender based violence escalating or re-occurring.

As we are now at the end of our evidence gathering, we would be grateful to receive a response by 9 October if possible.
