Dear Nick,

It has come to my attention that there is an important detail which needs to be corrected in relation to one of the examples referred to at the recent evidence session to the Sub Committee on the Smoke Free Premises (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2012.

In the session, I made reference to an occasion where a proposed Casualty storyline had to be dropped due to complications around filming a lit cigarette.

It has since been drawn to my attention by the Casualty production team that they found an alternative way of shooting the relevant scene. To be clear, no change was made to the plot of that episode.

The evidence I presented was given in good faith based on information I now know to be incorrect.

In the interest of presenting the facts as accurately as possible, I would be grateful if you could draw this to the attention of the Sub Committee members.

I would also be grateful for any guidance you can give on amending this part of our written supplementary evidence in light of this.

Please accept my sincere apologies for this error.
