Inter-Institutional Relations Agreement: British-Irish Council Summit in Dublin

Further to my letter of 23 November regarding the inter-institutional relations agreement and a British-Irish Council Summit being held in Ireland, I would like to draw your attention to my <u>written statement</u> of today, and to the BIC <u>communique</u> summarising the outcomes of the Summit.
