Thank you for your letter of 28 October, in which you requested an update on work being undertaken to develop an Integrated Quality Statement for Children's Health.

As I outlined in my response to the Committee's report on the 2025-26 Welsh Government Draft Budget, the Quality Statement will set out our clear expectations for health boards to deliver high-quality, equitable and effective health services for children in Wales.

My officials are working closely with the National Strategic Clinical Network for Child Health to co-produce a draft Quality Statement which will be shared with key stakeholders for detailed consideration in early 2026. This collaborative approach will ensure the Quality Statement reflects the challenges and priorities for service development and supports a shared understanding of the changes needed, going forward.

I anticipate the final Integrated Quality Statement for Children's Health will be published during March 2026.
