Petition P-06-1521 Give park home residents in Wales the right to a water meter

The Petitions Committee met on 24 November and considered the above petition, submitted by Sam Swash.

The Committee noted the responses from Ofwat and Dŵr Cymru, which expressed sympathy with the petitioners while also outlining their limitations on the issues raised.

Members agreed to write to Dŵr Cymru regarding the additional concerns raised by the petitioner, to draw these concerns to the attention of the Cabinet Secretary, and to highlight the petition to you as Chair of the Climate Change, Environment and Infrastructure Committee. The Committee has also encouraged the petitioner to engage directly in the consultation on the UK and Welsh Government's White Paper on water reforms.
