**Petition P-06-1541 Produce a Clean Water Bill for Wales and for Welsh Rivers**

The Petitions Committee met on 8 December and considered the above petition, submitted by Save the River Usk.

The Committee agreed there was nothing more the Petitions Committee could do, other than to highlight the petitioners' views and legislative proposals to the Deputy First Minister and Cabinet Secretary for Climate Change and Rural Affairs, and to you as the Chair of the Climate Change, Environment, and Infrastructure Committee, as the Environment (Principles, Governance and Biodiversity Targets) (Wales) Bill remains under scrutiny. Having done so, it was agreed to close the petition.

Members agreed that water quality and flood management should be priority themes to include in the Committee's legacy report to the next Senedd.
