DEVELOPMENT OF TOURISM AND REGULATION OF VISITOR ACCOMMODATION (WALES) BILL – REPORT STAGE GOVERNMENT AMENDMENTS

The information below is designed to explain the purpose and effect of the amendments tabled in the name of Mark Drakeford MS on 17 March 2026.

Adt.	Explanation
1	This amendment is to put beyond doubt that provision about the matters in paragraphs (a) to (e) of section 50(2), which may be made in regulations under subsection (1), relates to the transfer of premises or transfer of a business as a going concern. It also distinguishes those matters from those listed under subsection (2)(f).
2	This amendment is consequential to amendment 1, to address the internal cross-reference in section 50(3)(a).
