Thank you for attending the Scrutiny of the First Minister Committee on 13 March 2026. It was a useful and informative session and the Committee appreciated the opportunity to explore the Welsh Government's work over the last 5 years.

Due to time constraints, the Committee was unable to cover a small amount of issues, and would welcome a response/further clarity on the following:


During the meeting, Mark Isherwood asked you to confirm whether the proposed future framework for hospice and palliative care funding would be published in April. You stated that you would write to the Member to confirm this, please could you confirm when this will be published and whether you have written to Mark?

Following the discussion during the meeting on the Disability Confident scheme, would you be able to provide the Committee with greater clarity on how this scheme operates, and how any gaps for supporting young disabled people getting work opportunities will be filled?

When discussing the Strategic Programme for Planned Care, it was stated that 38 'enabling actions' were set out to reduce variation in access to services, with evidence to support each as good practice. You also noted that 34 of these have been delivered across all health boards. Could you provide further clarity on which four actions have not yet been achieved, the reasons for this, and what steps are being taken to ensure full delivery?

As this was the final session of this Senedd term, the Committee would like to extend thanks to you for your attendance during your time as First Minister. The Committee will soon publish its legacy report which looks back at the work carried out during this sixth Senedd, a copy of which will be sent to you separately.
