appointed as ambassadors or Chairs of childrens charities do not undergo

DBS checks. Most of these people get open door access to children because

of their position. In the light of the Jimmy Saville affair and the Ian Watkins

affair, will the Welsh Assembly now recognise that we can no longer blindly

accept people on the basis of their celebrity or social position and allow

them access to children.
