**Additional Information:** The usually prescribed treatment of Pernicious

Anaemia is one injection every three months. For a great many patients this

is totally inadequate. Some doctors will prescribe more frequent injections

but where this isn't the case patients are sourcing B12 injections from

various sources including the internet which is unsatisfactory. They then

inject themselves without any training and without using antiseptic wipes or

lockable sharps bins.
