## Dear Minister

The all Wales Stroke Implementation Group met at the end of March 2014. One of the items for discussion was the "Inquiry into Stroke Services" in particular the timescales for the delivery of carotid surgery and the proposals for and development of a campaign on stroke awareness.

We also had an in-depth discussion about the top priorities for the Stroke Implementation group over the next 2-3 years and stroke awareness, in particular AF was agreed as one of the top priorities for this group.

I have therefore commissioned a small group to work up proposals for awareness of AF and stroke, more generally and present proposal at our next meeting in June. I look forward to sharing these with you, once they are developed in more detail.

It was also agreed that a quick piece of work be undertaken on carotid surgery and once I have the responses from the Health Boards then I will be able to update you on the timescales for delivery.
