Children, Young People and Education Committee – Consultation on the draft Additional Learning Needs and Education Tribunal (Wales) Bill

Following the publication in July of the draft Additional Learning Needs and Education Tribunal (Wales) Bill for consultation, I am pleased to inform you that I have published today an initial working draft of a proposed Additional Learning Needs (ALN) Code, alongside an outline plan for implementation of the proposed new ALN system.
