
Dear First Minister,

Preparations for the outcome of the EU referendum

At the Enterprise and Business Committee's meeting on 9 March, we heard concerns from the CLA about the preparedness of governments for the EU referendum and its aftermath. In particular, whether planning and preparation was taking place in the event of a vote to leave.
