I wanted to take this opportunity to provide you with an update on my plans around advancing the children's rights agenda. I would like to thank the Committee once again for the wide ranging and in-depth inquiry into Children Rights in Wales.

I have reflected on the content of the report and I have decided to publish a revised Children's Rights Scheme, for consultation, in December. I have included a number of the Committee's recommendations within the draft scheme.

I am planning to host a roundtable discussion with key stakeholders from the children's sector on 14 January 2020, I will issue an invitation to you shortly. This event will provide an opportunity for me to update stakeholders on our revised Children's Rights Scheme and the compliance report on the due regard duty, which we will publish in the new year. It will also be an opportunity for us to discuss the lessons learned from the Covid-19 pandemic and the impact on children's rights.

I hope you will be able to attend.
