Thank you for the report on the Welsh Government's Legislative Consent Memoranda (LCM) on the Procurement Bill.

I am considering the five recommendations set out in your report and will provide a more substantive response soon. In the meantime, I wish to restate our position regarding Recommendation 1 which was provided to the Legislation, Justice, and Constitution Committee in my response to them on 14 November, as follows:

Recommendation 1. We recommend the Senedd's consent should also be sought for clauses 114 and 116, and any future memoranda in respect of the Bill should identify them accordingly.

I do not accept this recommendation.

I do not agree with the conclusion that clauses 114 and 116 of the Bill would amount to relevant provision for the purposes of Standing Order 29.

These clauses are technical provisions which are concerned with how the Bill works rather than substantive provisions, and as a matter of practice we do not generally include non-operative clauses within LCM.

Substantive responses will follow on the recommendations made in the report. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you need anything further.
