Further to my letter of 18 March 2024. I am writing to inform the Committee that I have given my consent to the Minister of State to lay the Official Controls (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2024 in relation to Wales. I have laid a Written Statement which can be found at:

Consent has been given for the UK Government to make these Regulations in order to implement to implement the milestones of the Borders Target Operating Model (BTOM). The Regulations intersect with devolved policy and will apply to Wales. The Statutory Instrument (SI) is subject to the negative procedure and was laid before Parliament on 22 April 2024 with a commencement date of the 30th April.
