4. Other activitied.

The Cross Party Group facilitates Assembly Member engagement in the Armed Forces Assembly Scheme.

Since the last AGM the Scheme has organised a visit to **Cambrian Patrol**, an annual international military patrolling exercise that makes its participating units cover a 50 mile course in less than 48 hours while performing numerous military exercises placed throughout the Cambrian Mountains, and a visit to RAF Valley, a Royal Air Force station on Anglesey which provides fighter jet pilot training and hosts an RAF Mountain Rescue team.

In June 2017, the Cross Party Group hosted a special service of remembrance in the Senedd to mark the 35th Anniversary of the end of the Falkland's conflict. Both the Llywydd and Deputy Presiding Officer were present at the service, and First Minister gave an address to those who gathered.
