**The Civil Enforcement of Parking
Contraventions (County Borough of
Caerphilly) Designation Order 2019**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order designates the area described in the Schedule to this Order as a civil enforcement area for parking contraventions and a special enforcement area for the purposes of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004. This Order enables Caerphilly County Borough Council to enforce parking contraventions within the area described in the Schedule to this Order through a civil law regime, as opposed to enforcement by police or traffic wardens in a criminal law context.

This Order is made by the Welsh Ministers⁽¹⁾ in exercise of the powers conferred on the National Assembly for Wales by paragraph 8(1) of Schedule 8 and paragraph 3(1) of Schedule 10 to the Traffic Management Act 2004⁽²⁾.

Caerphilly County Borough Council has applied to the Welsh Ministers for an Order to be made under these powers in respect of part of that Council's area.

The Welsh Ministers have consulted the chief officer of Gwent Police in accordance with the requirements of paragraph 8(3) of Schedule 8 and paragraph 3(4) of Schedule 10 to the Traffic Management Act 2004.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County Borough of Caerphilly) Designation Order 2019 and it comes into force on 8 April 2019.

(1) By virtue of section 92 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, the National Assembly for Wales was designated as the appropriate national authority as regards Wales, for the purposes of Part 6 of that Act. The functions of the National Assembly for Wales under the Traffic Management Act 2004 were transferred to the Welsh Ministers by virtue of section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32).

Designation of civil enforcement area for parking contraventions and special enforcement area

2. The Welsh Ministers designate the area described in the Schedule to this Order as—

- (a) a civil enforcement area for parking contraventions; and
- (b) a special enforcement area.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

Area designated as a civil enforcement area for parking contraventions and a special enforcement area

The area of the County Borough of Caerphilly (“the County Borough”) with the exception of—

- (a) the length of A465 Trunk Road within the County Borough, from the boundary with the County Borough of Merthyr Tydfil to the boundary with the County Borough of Blaenau Gwent, including its exit and entry slip roads.
