RG welcomed everyone to the third full meeting of the NAfW Cross Party Group on Transport, which was looking at ways to encourage more young people to use public transport and invited everyone to introduce themselves.

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 26 February 2019 had been circulated. There were no matters arising.

RG introduced each of the speakers in turn. Louise Coward of Transport Focus highlighted a UK wide survey by TF on what young people see as barriers against using public transport. Luke Davies of Traveline spoke of their experience in administering and marketing the Welsh Government's MyTravelPass Scheme for young people. Alex Rollason and Mark Barrow spoke with great conviction, and from experience, as young people and potential users of pubic transport.

A full round table discussion followed, involving many if the attendees. Important issues highlighted were the cost of public transport, the low take up of the MTP Scheme and the need to extend its age range. AMs were also able to question transport operators present on specific items.

There was no other business, and members present agreed to allow the chair and secretary to liaise over the date and subject of the next meeting and notify members and stakeholders appropriately.
