Do not support councils choosing their own voting system. The system needs to be the same across the whole of Wales. This will cause problems and it will mean that a council could vote in a system that benefits a ruling group rather than what is democratic and fair.

Do not support all council employees standing for election, council employees who have been public facing and have therefore potentially influenced the public in their role should not be able to stand. Those council employees who are remote from the main functions of the governance should only be able to stand.

Prisoners: Support those eligible to live in an area on discharge being able to vote if they are in prison

Committees: there should be a standard level of competence to be a Chair of a Committee and so this role should not be given only based on political balance.
